Dear Parent/Carer

We have had a great half term and the children have all settled really well. It is lovely to see them developing independence and adapting to school life with enthusiasm and enjoyment.

After half term we will be holding parent/carer consultation meetings. This will be an opportunity for you to speak with your child's teacher and have an update on their progress. The last couple of years these have been held via phone call however, this year, if you would like to meet face to face there will also be that option. Letters for appointments will be sent out the week we return to school.



If you wish your child to have hot school meals next half term please ensure these are ordered by Sunday 16th October.



We do like to ensure the children get outside for their PE lessons so please send them in outdoor PE kit as the weather turns colder. This should be black jogging trousers and a black hoodie/jacket.

On 21st October, we will be hosting a Macmillan coffee morning in school from 9.30am – 10.45am. Due to the large number of people attending in previous years we will be splitting the morning up. EYFS will hold theirs in their classroom, KS1 will be using the shared area just outside of their classrooms and KS2 will be in the hall. You will be able to collect your children and sit with them but we do ask that no hot drinks are taken into classrooms. The children will be baking in school next week but we would also appreciate any donations of cakes brought in on the morning.



Next Thursday, 20th October, the children may come to school in non-uniform for a donation of £1. This is to try and raise some extra funds for MacMillan Cancer Research.



Our conversion to join WellSpring Multi-Academy Trust is progressing well. These processes can take a long time due to all the legalities and new systems that need setting up but we are on track to join them very early in the new year.
