## SEND - Intent, Implement, Impact

### Intent:

At Coomb Briggs Primary Academy, it is our intention to provide a high quality education for all our pupils, including pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), and to do everything we can to meet the needs of pupils with SEND.

At Coomb Briggs Primary School, we are committed to offering an inclusive curriculum to ensure the best possible progress for all of our pupils whatever their needs or abilities.

### We will:

- Do our best to ensure that early identification and intervention is in place to maximise outcomes and progress.
- Set high expectations for all pupils and ensure constant inclusion of all pupils
- Provide pupils with SEND, with high quality teaching, differentiated to their individual needs
- Ensure all pupils have access to a broad and balanced curriculum
- Ensure that all children have access to an environment that is tailored to their needs
- Ensure pupils with SEND will take part in highly motivating activities, personalised to their needs
- Provide opportunities for pupils with SEND to develop their independence and life skills
- Have good partnerships with parents/carers
- Ensure staff working alongside pupils with SEND, have the relevant training.

### Implementation:

At Coomb Briggs Primary Academy, all teachers are teachers of SEND.

At Coomb Briggs Primary Academy, you will see pupils with SEND:

- being included in all aspects of the school day and life, including educational visits, after school clubs and whole school events
- having targeted support or small group intervention to support academic, personal, social and emotional development. These are personalised to the individual pupil.
- working with professionals from outside agencies (SALT, OT, SAS Teachers or EPs)
- completing activities following a multi-sensory and hands-on approach
- especially for those with high and/or specific SEND, following a bespoke curriculum tailored to their needs.

## Impact:

As a result:

- Pupils are safe and happy at Coomb Briggs Primary Academy
- Pupils feel that their voice is heard and listened to
- Pupils with SEND make good progress, in all areas of their development, from their starting point
- Parents/carers are informed of and are happy with the provision in place for their child
- Pupils with SEND have developed good independence and life skills.
