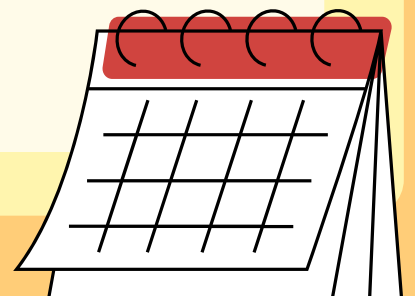

- Sports Day Monday 13th July. If the weather is not suitable for Sports day this will be postponed to Tuesday 14th July.

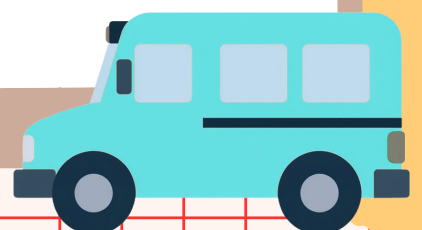

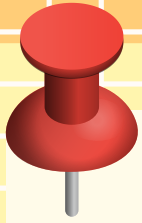

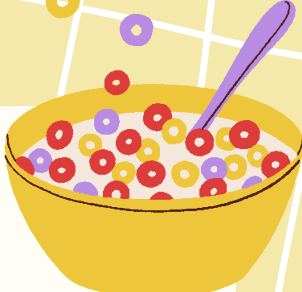
